AFFIDAVITS IN SUPPORT:

These affidavits were written by David Robitaille and mailed from prison to their respective recipients with instruction to make any and all modifications, and then sign or don't sign. No modifications were made. All were signed.

They demonstrate the true character of David Robitaille.

NOTE: The intention, at one point during incarceration and a particularly emotionally painful period, David decided to begin work on a civil action against the alleged victim and his mother. While nothing became of this, the Affidavits of both mother Margret Robitaille and sister Marlene Plant are relevant to this case as they both demonstrate that no sexual assault or rape of any kind could have occurred at Margret Robitaille Stonina Drive address as alleged due to the 24/7 manned nonprofit stationed there; or police and social services. The Commonwealth did not question anyone other than Richard Ventura and his mother Virginia. Otherwise, they would have avoided alleging a false criminal activity at a time and place it could never have occurred.

- 6. Was this office equipped with two 24 hour "hot-line" phones which were maned at all times, as well as an oke desk and chair??
- 7. Were you one of the members of SLAM designated to answer these two phones?
- 8. Did you share this job with anyone else?, and if so, who?
- 9. Did the head quarters of SLAM at your Stoning Drive address have an open-door policy where anyone could come visit the organization at any time?

- 1. I, Larry Keizer, hereby depose and say the following:
- 2. I am the foster brother of the above-named defendant, David Robitaille.
- 3. I write this affidavit in support of the defendant's release on his personal recognizance to the best of my knoledge.
- 4. I first met David Robitaille when he was a foster child living with my mother and I in Springfield, MA.
- 5. As time passed, David and I became good friends, both while he was staying with us and after he moved on. I can say that I know him better than most people.
- 6. I first learned of David's crime situation when he called me from the police station the night of his arrest. He called me for his one phone call.
- David's charges are not consistent with his personality. David hates violence. He has never been in a fight in his life. Although he was interested in the marshal arts for a while, he never used the little he knew to harm anyone. For the most part, David staied to himself.
- 8. I know that David has had problems resulting from abuse while in foster care throughout his life, but he is not the type of young man who would force anyone to do anything.
- 9. The court should allow David to be released into my custody. He would be living with mc until the outcome of this matter, and for as long as is needed. I am deeply concerned for David and his well being, and feel that my moral support will be of great help to him at this time.

- 10. It is my understanding that David himself got his case back into the court, so it would be consistent with his personality to see this matter through until the end. David always finishes what he starts.
- 11. I am willing to take responsibility for David and will make sure he makes all of his court appointments. He has several civil cases in court, so I will make sure that he he makes those appointments as well.

- 13. I ask this court to release David Robitaille on his own personal recognizance, and in my custody.



AFFIDAVIT OF CHARLES F. DEBARGER IN SUPPORT OF DEFENDANT'S RELEASE ON PERSONAL RECOGNIZANCE

- 1. I, Charles F. DeBarger, hereby depose and say the following:
- I am a friend of the above-named defendant, David Robitaille.
- 3. I write this affidavit in support of the defendant's release on his personal recognizance to the best of my knowledge.
- 4. David and I met one summer's day in 1981, while I was restoring the clay tennis courts in Springfield's Forest Park. David was passing by and stopped to ask me if I needed any help. I said I was just about finished for the day, but that I had a group coming the next day to work on the courts with me, and if he wanted to come back I'd be glad to have his help. He did come back.
- 5. For the next three or four years, David helped keep up the courts. He did this of his own free will, and without pay. I found that surprising—it's so seldom you find a kid who volunteers to help with anything. David worked hard during some pretty hot weather, too.
- 6. When I learned of David's offense, I couldn't believe the charge. I knew he had been in foster homes and had had some personal problems, but it was not in his character to force anyone to do anything the person didn't want to do. David didn't like violence.
- 7. Over the years, we had talked many times, about many things. I had suggested once that he go into the military, where they would train him in a skill that would help him get a good job. He didn't like the idea: he didn't like the possibility of being trained to kill.
- 8. I believe that David has matured since those early days when he committed the transgression for which he has spent five years in jail. I believe he is committed to avoiding situations that could lead to trouble. I believe he is ready to begin a new chapter in the rest of his life.

- 9. I have spoke with David's brother Robert, and from what he has told me about him, I feel that David is telling the truth about not having forced the boy into anything. I do not know the boy, but I do know David, and I feel that there is more to this situation than meets the eye.
- 10. Concerning David's employment upon release, I own a construction company in Hartland CT., and am willing to have David as an employee. He would be under constant supervision by me during work hours. Our work does not involve working with or around children, so the court should have no concerns in that respect.
- 11. David would have the opportunity to attend church with my family, if allowed release by this court, and I feel that this would help him to reintegrate into society.
- 12. The longer David is institutionalized, the worse off I feel he will be. He needs the love and support of the church community, and a feeling of belonging.
- 13. I know that David has been going to counseling right from the start. He has made many attempts to obtain specialized counseling from a psychologist friend of mine. However, the prison would not allow it.
- 14. I have seen this young man go from a confused child, to a head strong adult who knows his purpose in life, and who has hopes, dreams, and goals. Also, I see David as someone who has a lot to offer society if given the chance.
- 15. I feel that David would see this criminal case through without making any attempts to evade the law. He has worked bard on his case and has told me that he wishes to see it through until the end. I support his release on personal recognizance, and have provided him with some money to be used for bail If needed. I do not consider him at risk of flight.
